JAPAN HOSTS TWO OF SPORTS BIGGEST TOURNAMENTS THE 2020 RESCHEDULED GAMES & THE 2019 RUGBY WORLD CUP

Twelve Japanese stadiums were used to host the successful Rugby World Cup, which featured 45 exciting matches during the autumn of 2019. Most of these stadiums will be reused for the Tokyo Games in 2021, The Japan National Stadium hosts the opening and the closing ceremonies, as well as the athletics. This brand new stadium is scheduled to be the home for the Japanese national football and national rugby teams.
